Admission Criteria:

Your 2-year-old can get free early education and childcare if you live in England and get one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Universal Credit - and your household income is £15,400 a year or less after tax, not including benefit payments
- tax credits and you have an annual income of under £16,190 a year or less before tax
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- the Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

A child can also get free early education and childcare if any of the following apply:

- they're looked after by a local council
- they have a current statement of [special education needs \(SEN\)](#) or an education, health and care (EHC) plan
- they get [Disability Living Allowance](#)
- have left care under an adoption order, special guardianship order, child arrangements order or adoption order

If you think that your child qualifies, you can complete an online application form at www.lincolnshire.gov.uk/2yearolds.

Places will be allocated on a strictly birth date order. If we are oversubscribed, names will be put on a waiting list.

The exceptions to the strictly birth date order are:

- a) 2 year funded pupils.
- b) Children in Public Care aged, if considered appropriate to meet the needs of the child.
- c) Children with a 'Children in Need' plan, if considered appropriate to meet the needs of the child.
- d) Children with Special Education Needs if considered appropriate to meet the child's needs.
- e) Children subject to a Common Assessment Framework if considered appropriate to meet the child's needs.

If you're a non-EEA citizen who cannot claim benefits, your 2 year old may get free childcare if you are getting support under the Immigration and Asylum Act and have either claimed asylum in the UK and are waiting for a decision or have been refused asylum in the UK

The Governing body of Gainsborough Nursery School wish you to know that the criteria specified is strictly adhered to and that all applications received by 28th February will be discussed in one session (not on a first come basis). There is no legal requirement that 2 year old children must have a place in school and as such there is no right of appeal against a decision not to offer a child a place.
